With that thought - it's time to fundraise and prepare for this year's Pan Mass Challenge (PMC). This will be Chuck's 23rd year where he mounts the bike to ride 192 miles from Sturbridge to Provincetown in support of Cancer research and treatment. What's more - Jody, Spencer and Annika will volunteer at the final water stop in on the Cape in Wellfleet. It's a family affair and a big one! So many of you have been consistent in your support, and that consistency leads us to take this on again this year.

To review last year - we came very close to the \$6k goal we set - a grand total of \$5575. There were no major incidents during the ride and the weather was cooperative, but let's just say Chuck and his buddy Pete weren't leading the group in speed stats.

- *The PMC has fueled Dana Farber's emergence as a leading center for what's being called 'precision medicine' where the patient's individual DNA informs the treatment. A growing bank of tumor DNA data improves this process every year.*
- *In a span of 5 weeks beginning late 2015 - the FDA approved 5 new cancer drugs in Dana-Farber-led clinical trials. This kind of work benefits treatment worldwide.*
- *A unique event that donates 100% of rider-raised funds directly to Dana Farber.*

We're proud to tell you about the first training ride of the season. In late June, Spencer Johnson (age 13) joined Chuck for a 2 day - 110 mile ride from Chuck's folks in Sandwich, NH back to our house in Ipswich, MA. We made fewer stops than a typical PMC, but of course consumed less healthy food. Spencer has announced he might like to take on the PMC someday - we'll have to see on that - but he's quite a rider and a great training partner.
